Dear Parents of 6th-8th Grade students,

Ring Lardner Middle School offers a 1-to-1 computer environment. Each 6th-8th Grade student will be provided with a Chromebook, which will remain in the school building unless instructed otherwise. Much of the work and learning done in middle school will take place on this tool.



A signed *Student Technology Acceptable Use and Safety* [NCS Board Administrative Guideline ag7540.03] document (see handbook) must first be on record before students can be assigned a device.

Possessing a board-owned, school-issued Chromebook presents both risks and responsibility. Because of this risk, all families are encouraged to purchase a type of insurance (district or private) for the Chromebook before it is assigned to the student.

The district is offering an optional protection plan priced at \$10 per year with no deductible, assuming damage is accidental (determination to be made by principal and technology director). As long as the incident is NEITHER negligent, nor intentional, the plan will cover one occurrence each of damage to: keyboard, touchpad, battery, hard disk, and screen. Additional, negligent or intentional damage will be billed to the student's family accordingly (see rate schedule on the reverse of this page). If you elect to waive the district protection plan, the student's family assumes full responsibility/liability for the device [NCS Board Policy po7530].

If the Chromebook is ever damaged or broken, your student should bring it to the office. We'll then issue a temporary device and have the original repaired or replaced as soon as possible. The only exception is the charging adapter, as these can not be replaced or repaired as part of our coverage.

Also, we will be talking with the students about the appropriate use of the Chromebooks. They are incredible tools but can also present a large distraction in our environment. We will encourage students to use the Chromebooks to research, collaborate, word process, and create. Conversely, watching movies, listening to music, chatting, and playing games are activities they need to avoid on this device. Please help us by reinforcing this expectation.
